Community Co-ordinator

We are delighted to have appointed Liz Bruce as our Community Co-ordinator for the scheme. Liz has a wealth of experience in community nursing (in Norfolk) where she worked in a variety of posts for 30 years. She is very experienced in joint working and project work.

When Liz moved to Scotland she worked as a receptionist/dispenser in Port Appin Surgery.

She left Scotland 4 yrs ago. Liz is immensely enthusiastic about the project and so proud to be the Coordinator.

She is also so pleased to be back in the area which feels like home!

Appin and Lismore Community Care scheme. (A&LCC)

You can get support to live in your own home.

How it works

In Scotland free personal care is provided for anyone who has eligible needs over the age of 65 years. The Social Care (Self Directed Support) Scotland Act allows people to choose how their support is provided to them.

1-REFERRAL

To receive care at home you will be referred to the Social Work Department in Oban. A referral to the department can be made by anyone (including the person) if they are concerned about a friend or family member. A G.P can also make a referral.

2 -ASSESSMENT

A Social Worker will visit and assess your needs. Following the assessment you will be informed of your budget to enable you to plan your support.

3-YOU CHOOSE

Under the provision of A&LCC you can

OPTION 1. You can receive a direct payment from Social Services for you to arrange your own support and care. (this will mean employing someone to care for you)

OPTION 2. This option enables you to use Appin and Lismore Community Care Services. You direct your own care and support, the money is managed by Highland Home Carers (an individual service fund provider) and can only be used for your care.

4-CARE-YOU TAKE CONTROL

If you have chosen Option 1-you will be required to set up a bank account and employ someone to provide your care and support.

If you have chosen Option 2-As soon as finances are in place the Social Worker will inform Appin and Lismore Community Care Coordinator Liz Bruce who will arrange to visit you to discuss and plan & implement your care.

You can choose care and support that helps you to achieve the things that have been agreed in your plan, you can get support to live in your own home. How you use the hours that have been allocated to you is up to you.
